The Greenland skin-on-frame kayak's to be built on this course will be based on Thomas Hawson's experience in making the design from Petersen's book, *Instructions in Kayak Building. 2001*. Thomas has made three versions of the Greenland kayak, assisted two others in making kayaks, and has had three years experience paddling them. He now feels confident providing guidance in making a boat that feels good to the end user.

Kayaks made on this course will be tailored to suit the experience and aspirations of their makers. All participants will be guided through the hull shape choices to provide them with a comfortable fun boat to enhance their sea-paddling interests. The Greenland skin-on-frame kayak is suited to day-paddling on the sea, and as a low volume boat for practicing the numerous traditional rolls. They are also beautiful replicas of the original kayaks which feed the imagination and deserve a place on the wall or ceiling of any enthusiast's home.
